Indianapolis has a citywide poverty rate of 19%. However, the poverty rate for youth in the Crown Hill neighborhood is 40%.

That's two out of every five youth—right here in a local neighborhood—living in poverty. Even worse, the poverty rate in the Meadows neighborhood—where We Care Indy is located, is 42 percent!

of youth in certain areas in Indianapolis live below the poverty level

Since 2014, We Care Indy has employed and mentored <u>over</u> 200 at-risk youth in Indianapolis.



Many of our youth come from high crime index zip codes, including <u>46219</u>, <u>46229</u>, <u>46226</u>, <u>and 46218</u>, where the risk is over 50% higher than in other areas of Indiana</u>.

The number of homicides in Indianapolis in the <u>19</u> and under age group has reached an all time high since 2018.




Youth killed by guns in 2023

We Care Indy FAQs

- 1. Who is We Care Indy? In Indianapolis, a beacon of hope stands out among the struggles of violence and poverty. We Care Indy seeks to empower young people by providing valuable guidance and employment opportunities. Their focus is media training with teenagers aged 14-19. Their plan is innovative and ambitious, blending mentorship programs with career development. The cornerstone of this plan is the creation of Career Centers a hub of inspiration that provides training programs in a variety of fields, including media, construction, I.T., and entrepreneurship.
- 2. What is the age group for students/participants? 14 years old to 19 years old
- 3. Do students/participants have to be members of a church? **No**, students do not have to be a member of a church.
- 4. Is there an application fee? No, there is no application fee.
- 5. Is this a paid program? If so, how much do students/participants earn per hour? Yes, this is a paid program. Students receive \$10 per hour.
- 6. When do the program sessions start? June 2024
- 7. How Long is the program? The program lasts for 42 weeks, and upon completion, students can sign up for the next session. Additionally, they will have the opportunity to take on a more leadership-oriented role.



- 8. What are the trade skills that will be taught during the sessions? *This year's focus will teach young people the skills of videography, photography, video editing, graphic design, lighting, audio, social media, marketing, website development, and business plan writing.*
- 9. Are there volunteer opportunities as a facilitator? Yes, there are volunteer opportunities for a facilitator who wants to teach some of their experiences to the youth. If you are interested, email weekersess weekersess weekersess
